13 day Fly In Safari 'All around Namibia'

Windhoek – Etosha - Kunene - Damaraland – Skeleton Coast - Swakopmund
Sossusvlei – Namib - Fish river Canyon - Kalahari – Windhoek

Day 1) After arrival at Windhoek Hosea Kutako Airport you meet your private charter plane & pilot and fly directly to Ongava Lodge, on the edge of Etosha national park.

In the afternoon take part your first game drive on the private reserve.

Day 2) Take a walk 'on the wild side' with your ranger in search for rhino in the reserve. In the afternoon a game drive in Etosha or in the Ongava private reserve. With luck you may see lions and many other african game species.

Day 3) Your pilot takes you to the very remote Kunene region, where the river borders on Angola. During your scenic flight across the Hartmann's Valley, you notice numerous herds of springbok and oryx antelopes, as well as a large number of the mysterious 'fairy circles'. Take part in an afternoon boat trip on the Kunene River and enjoy your luxurious accommodation.

Day 4) Today you will explore your surrounding area. One highlight follows the next. From a visit to the colorful Himba tribe, to a 4x4 drive across this amazing dune & mountain landscape, a walk along the Kunene river, famous for its large crocodiles, bird viewing or quad-biking across the sand dunes.

Day 5) Your fly in safari takes you south again, across rocky mountains and open gravel-plains. There will be fantastic photographic opportunities from the air. Upon arrival in Damaraland, you have the possibility to view some of the oldest rock-engravings at Twyfelfontein. It is Namibia's first ' World Heritage Site'.

Day 6) You may wish to take part in another drive this morning – in search of the desert elephant. We depart along the lonely Skeleton Coast southwards. Along this route you have a wonderful view of the dunes meeting the sea, shipwrecks covered by sand, bird and seal colonies. Arrival in the popular coastal resort Swakopmund. Afternoon free to explore and for shopping.

Day 7) You will be transferred to Walvis Bay for your boat cruise. Your trip will take you passed oyster farms and a variety of sea birds to Pelican Point, which is home to a seal colony. With luck you may spot dolphins & pelicans. The afternoon is free.

Day 8) Fly further southwards across Sandwich and Conception Bay, where the wreck of the ship 'Edward Bohlen' can be seen prominently from the air. Carry on into the Namib Desert with its high dunes. Experience the picturesque landscape in its full grandeur from the air and later on your afternoon drive in the nature reserve.

Day 9) Early morning, when the light conditions are the best, depart on your excursion to Sossusvlei. Test your endurance when climbing some of the highest dunes in the world. Capture this magnificent sight with your camera for your remembrance - Age old camel thorn trees - cracked dried out clay pans- space vegetation and desert adapted animals – to complete the picture and your experience

Day 10) We carry on into the southern parts of the Nama Karoo desert region to the majestic Fish river Canyon. From the bird's eye perspective one can best grasp the grandeur of its size.

During an afternoon nature drive, guests have the possibility to experience the Canyon from the main view point and learn about its interesting geology and fauna and flora of the area.

Day 11) Spend the day at leisure or with optional activities The Canyon Lodge is scenically situated between large granite boulders and lends itself for small hikes, bird watching, horse-riding or sundowner drives.

Day 12) Your pilot takes you to another important desert in Namibia – the red Kalahari.

You have the possibility to take part in a sundowner drive, where you will also have the chance to see cheetah, amongst other game. The area is also famous for its large sociable weaver's nests and red dunes partially covered by desert vegetation.

Day 13) Charter flight back to Windhoek where you are dropped at the International Airport, or if you intend to spend a last night in Windhoek- at Eros airport.
