



Caprivi to Vic Falls 6 days / 5 nights

Day 1

Depart for Okahandja where we visit the Herero graves and a local handicraft market. Continue via Otjiwarongo towards Namibia's north and arrive at Otavi during the early afternoon. The Khorab Lodge offers a personal service in a relaxed atmosphere.

Day 2

We will travel north towards Rundu. En route we visit the Hoba Meteorite near Grootfontein. After we pass the veterinary fence we enter "rural Africa" of the Kavango region. The area is the "water-richest" part of the country. There is a complex of rivers carrying water throughout the year and a high summer rainfall making this a fertile wilderness of riverside forests, flood plains, swamps and open woodland. This is a fantastic birders paradise. Towards sunset we participate on a cruise on the river.

Situated next to the Mahango National Park is the thatched and comfortably styled Mahangu Safari Lodge. A deck offers a picturesque view of the sunsets.

Day 3

Undertake a game drive along the floodplains of Mahango Game Park. View the Popa Falls and enjoy a packed lunch before continuing to Mudumu National Park. Gaming activity around sunset at your lodge near the Kwando River.

Namushasha Lodge is situated 24 km south of the small town Kongola.

Day 4

Join a cultural tour at the Living Museum of the Mafwe people. Return to the lodge for lunch. Enjoy a boat cruise on the Kwando River in the afternoon. Crocodile, hippo, elephant, buffalo, roan antelope, kudu, impala and zebra are more than likely to be encountered. The bird life is well in abundance for bird watchers, as more than 400 bird species are found here.

Day 5

Today the route takes us via Katima Mulilo to the major center of the Caprivan artists and craftspeople and on to Kasane. On Botswana's far northern border lies the Kwando, Linyanti and Chobe river system forming a series of lakes, islands and floodplains. This area forms the Chobe National Park, famous for its large buffalo and elephant herds. In addition to a variety of predators, there is an abundance of wild game and bird life which decorate these beautiful waterways.

In the afternoon you take part in a boat cruise on the Chobe River

Day 6

After a relaxed breakfast, guests are collected from Chobe Safari Lodge by a separate transfer (included in tour) and dropped off at a hotel / airport in Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe) or Livingstone (Zambia)
